We are delighted to welcome you to our Hospital in Curraheen for your respite care. This leaflet contains important information.

- A set-down area is provided at the main door for admission purposes.
- A charge applies to the visitors of respite admissions using the Hospital Car Park.
- The first 30 days respite in any 12 month period is provided free. A charge of €25 per night is levied thereafter by the HSE and must be paid on admission. Please see the front cover of this leaflet if a charge applies to you for this admission. (Health Amendment Act 2005).
- Accommodation will be provided in a shared room (four beds).
- This Hospital is a non-smoking hospital. Outdoor areas are provided for residents only who wish to smoke.
- We request that you do not bring in large sums of money or valuables to the Hospital. A locked press for small sums of petty cash (not exceeding €100) will be made available to you if required. The Hospital cannot accept responsibility for loss of money or valuables.
- Services provided to the Hospital by outside contractors, which you might like to avail of are listed on the back on this leaflet along with prices.
- Should you need to attend any pre-arranged appointments during your stay, please make the appropriate travel arrangements with family/friends.
- Should any medical issues arise during your stay, access to medical cover will be provided.
- All respite residents will be asked to pay the Government Levy of €2.50 per item on any newly prescribed items directly to the community pharmacist who dispenses the prescription during your stay. A bill will be issued to you if a cost is incurred.
- Mass is celebrated in the Hospital Oratory on Sunday, Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

IMPORTANT CHECKLIST

Please organise transport so that you arrive to the hospital on or before 3.30pm (late arrivals/admissions significantly affects other residents and staff commitments).

Please bring the following items with you:

A current prescription signed by your doctor

(The prescription must include all the medication you are taking. Please include Warfarin book if applicable.)

A supply of medication for the duration of your stay

(Please bring in all prescribed medications in their containers or in their boxes that were dispensed by your local pharmacist. Marymount will NOT, under any circumstances, accept prescribed medications in blister packs/any pre-packed arrangements.)

Note: If you do not have a current prescription signed by your doctor, or a supply of all medication you are taking, your admission may be delayed or postponed.

Any appliances that you use at home on a day-to-day basis, e.g. walking aids, nebulisers, oxygen concentrator, etc.

An adequate supply of personal clothing for your stay
(No laundry service is provided. Towels are provided)

A supply of toiletries including liquid soap
(not bars of soap). Hospital Shop located near Reception

A supply of incontinence wear, if applicable

A supply of wound dressings, if applicable

Hip protectors – if you wear these at home, please bring your supply with you.
